Union Fair Campground Policy

Union Fair offers fair patrons, exhibitors, and vendors a level, shaded, grassy campground for your self-contained camper or rv. We have available 20-, 30- and 50-amp sites with water hook-ups. The campground is located inside the fairgrounds and within easy walking distance to events and attractions. The campground remains surprisingly quiet even during the day for those who wish to take a break from all the festivities and refresh before taking on the evening action. Come for a day or for several days. Enjoy all Union Fair has to offer without fighting traffic and relax when you want in the privacy of your "home" just steps away from the action.

There are currently no septic sites, but we do offer a conveniently located dump station for those camping during the week. Fill your blue-boy, and dump at no additional charge. For campers entering fairgrounds, we do offer initial dumping for \$30. If you wish to have your camper pumped during the week, and don't want to cart your blue-boy, arrange with the superintendent for the honey wagon to visit your site for \$30.

- Self-Contained campers and/or rv's are encouraged, but we do accept tenters as well.
- No open fires, fire-pits, or similar type devices.
- Check in is 2:00 p.m.
- Check out is requested by 11:00 a.m. unless arrangement is made with the camping supervisor.
- You may be required to move RV to a non-site parking area to accommodate an arriving camper staying overnight.
- Quiet hours in the campground are from 11 PM to 8 AM. Please respect your fellow campers as they may be fair volunteers and staff putting in long hours.
- Clean your campsite before you leave. We provide you with plenty of trash receptacles.
- Although dogs are not permitted on the fairgrounds (except service dogs), we do allow for your canine friends to accompany you on leash around the campsite, the area adjacent the exit road, or the exit road itself for your walks. Please clean up after your pet!
- Incessant barking will not be tolerated. Again, please respect your fellow campers as they may be catching a midday nap.
- All prepaid and onsite campers shall adhere to the Union Fair Admission rates regardless of arrival time (must have a reserved & pre-paid campsite). Although reservations are not required, we do encourage pre-registration and pre-payment to facilitate easy access to the grounds and your campsite. Campers arriving without a reservation will pay the admission fee at the front gate, and then visit the camping office to pay for the campsite.

Campground Rates

Rates shown are per night. All Campers must also purchase a daily admission ticket.

- 20-amp service site = \$30.00/night plus State of Maine 9% lodging tax
- 30-amp service site = \$35.00/night plus State of Maine 9% lodging tax
- 50-amp service site = \$40.00/night plus State of Maine 9% lodging tax
